

Open Government Impact Statement

80th Oregon Legislative Assembly 2019 Regular Session

Measure: HB 3273

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SUMMARY

Directs each manufacturer of prescription drugs that are sold within this state to develop and implement drug take-back program for purpose of collecting from individuals and nonbusiness entities prescription drugs for disposal.

Directs Department of Environmental Quality and Environmental Quality Commission to administer Act. Requires manufacturers subject to Act to first submit plan for participating in drug take-back program on or before July 1, 2020. Requires drug take-back programs to be operational by February 1, 2021.

Becomes operative January 1, 2020.

Sunsets September 15, 2031.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure any financial, manufacturing or sales information or data collected from drug manufacturers or take-back organizations by the Department of Environmental Quality in implementing the secure drug take-back program.

If these public records were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, trade secret information of drug manufacturers would more likely be made public.
