Appropriates moneys to Higher Education Coordinating Commission for purposes of prison education programs.

**Analysis:** This bill appropriates \$500,000 General Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to provide and expand educational programs in correctional facilities. \$350,000 would be distributed to the University of Oregon and \$150,000 would be distributed to Blue Mountain Community College for the staff and other costs of providing instructional services in the correctional facilities.
