Measure Description:

Requires Housing and Community Services Department to provide grants to nonprofit organizations for providing housing services to low income people undergoing treatment for HIV. Appropriates moneys to department for grants.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Housing and Community Services Department (HCSD)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Human Services and Housing to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The legislation directs the Housing and Community Service Department (HCSD) to provide grants to nonprofits that provide housing services to individuals who are low income, homeless, or at risk of becoming homeless and are engaged in ongoing HIV case management services. A General Fund (GF) appropriation of \$1.5 million is provided to HCSD in the 2019-21 biennium for administration costs and grant funding. Grant funds are not to be distributed more frequently than quarterly and the first payments will be made no later than March 30, 2020. HCSD must report to the Legislative Assembly not later than September 15, 2021 regarding the expenses of and services provided through the grants.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
