#### Analysis:

SB 452 directs the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to study the responses of emergency medical services to rare medical conditions, particularly those conditions requiring emergency use medications for treatment. OHA is required to report findings and recommendations to the Legislature by February 1, 2020.

OHA estimates the contract to conduct this study to be \$182,400 General Fund.

This measure requires budgetary action for the allocation of General Fund resources.
