Measure Description:

Requires school districts to provide instruction and drills on how to prepare for and survive after natural disaster.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education (ODE), Education Service Districts (ESD), School Districts

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the [House Committee on Veterans and Emergency Preparedness to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure directs the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to establish and administer a pilot program to assist school districts in age-appropriate instruction on natural disasters. In addition, the bill has a blank General Fund appropriation.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on ODE, School Districts, and Education Service Districts.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
