Measure Description:

Changes fees charged by State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries for permits for mineral exploration, mining operations, exclusion certificates, gas and oil drilling and exploration, and geothermal well drilling operation.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Geology and Mineral Industries (DOGAMI)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Environment and Natural Resources to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The legislation increases fees charged by Department of Geology and Minerals (DOGAMI) for permits for mineral exploration, mining operations, exclusion certificates, gas and oil drilling and exploration, and geothermal well drilling operation. The legislation corresponds to the agency budget (HB 5511).
