Measure Description:

Directs Department of Human Services to distribute \$1 million to Center for the Prevention of Abuse and Neglect to conduct Oregon Child Abuse Prevalence Study.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Human Services (DHS)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Human Services and Housing to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure appropriates \$1,000,000 General Fund to the Department of Human Services (DHS) and directs the department to distribute funds to the Center for the Prevention of Abuse and Neglect, \$600,000 between July 1, 2019, and June 30, 2020, and \$400,000 between July 1, 2020, and June 30, 2021, for the Oregon Child Abuse Prevalence Study. The measure directs DHS to require the Center for the Prevention of Abuse and Neglect to spend not more than 10% of the funds to pay the University of Oregon for facilities and administrative costs.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Department of Human Services.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
