Measure Description:

Requires public universities, community colleges and community college districts to require contractors to employ apprentices and to establish and execute plan for outreach, recruitment and retention of women and minority individuals for certain work relating to improvements to real property.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Community Colleges, Public Universities, Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Education to the Senate Committee Rules.

The measure requires public universities, community colleges and community college districts to require contractors to employ apprentices and to establish and execute plan for outreach, recruitment and retention of women and minority individuals for certain work relating to improvements to real property.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, universities, and community colleges.
