**Measure Description:**

Authorizes juvenile offender charged with offense subject to mandatory minimum sentence, who receives mandatory minimum sentence or other sentence of imprisonment, to be eligible for conditional release after serving at least one-half of sentence imposed.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

District Attorneys and their Deputies (DAs), Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision (BPPPS), Department of Corrections (DOC), Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Public Defense Services Commission (PDSC), Criminal Justice Commission (CJC), Department of Justice (DOJ), Oregon Youth Authority (OYA)

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
