Measure Description:

Establishes product stewardship program for mattresses.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Environment and Natural Resources to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The legislation establishes a program with the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) for the financing, collection and environmentally sound management of discarded mattresses. Retailers must collect an assessment at the point of sale for a mattress and remit the payment to an approved stewardship organization. DEQ must adopt rules for an annual fee to be paid by approved stewardship organizations to fund the agency’s administration costs.

The bill is anticipated to have a fiscal impact on DEQ. A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
