**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Appropriates \$\_\_\_\_\_ to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) beginning July 1, 2019. Allows Department to expend moneys for activities related to summer steelhead hatchery production for the Santiam River. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Amount of hatchery fish
- Impacts on native fish
- Tourism industry

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Santiam River is a tributary of the Willamette River, in western Oregon. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife operates and manages the hatchery on the Santiam River for the United States Army Corps of Engineers as part of the Corps dam mitigation program.

House Bill 3016 appropriates moneys to the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife for activities related to summer steelhead hatchery production for the Santiam River.
