Measure Description:

Authorizes city that was annexed into a county service district to petition county board for withdrawal from district.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Special Districts, Cities, Counties

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

Costs related to the measure are indeterminate at this time - See explanatory analysis.

Analysis:

The legislation permits the governing body of a city to petition a county board to withdraw the city from a county service district. Within 90 days following the withdrawal, the governing bodies of the city and the district shall negotiate and finalize an agreement for the equitable division and disposal of the assets of the district. If the governing bodies of the city and the district are unable to agree on an equitable division and disposal of the district's assets, the governing body of the city or district may petition the circuit court of the county in which the city has its legal situs, and maintains its seat of city government, to determine an equitable division and disposal of the district's assets.

Potential fiscal implications for cities and county service districts will be determined by the result of negotiations between the two entities; the ramifications of this measure cannot be fully predicted and therefore the fiscal impact cannot be determined.
