Measure Description:

Directs certifying agencies to certify to United States Citizenship and Immigration Services, within specified time, victim helpfulness in detecting, investigating or prosecuting qualifying criminal activity.

District Attorneys and their Deputies (DAs), Criminal Justice Commission (CJC), Department of Justice (DOJ), Cities, Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Counties, Oregon State Police (OSP)

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
