WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Recognizes and honors Officer Malcus Williams II (1966-2018) for his service to Oregon.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

BACKGROUND:

Malcus Williams II was born in Eugene and graduated from Willamette High School. He later attended Southern Oregon State College where he played football. He began his career in law enforcement as a reserve officer with the Ashland Police Department (APD) in 1994; two years later he was sworn in as a full-time officer. He completed a bachelor's degree at Southern Oregon while working full-time for APD. Officer Williams died in the line of duty while responding to a call on March 2, 2018. He was posthumously awarded Oregon's Law Enforcement Medal of Ultimate Sacrifice.
