BACKGROUND:

The Oregon Educators Equity Act (2015) required that each teacher education program prepare a plan for recruitment, admission, retention, and graduation of diverse educators. House Bill 3010 establishes a Task Force on Educator Attraction and Retention, to examine educator shortages in this state.
