Measure Description:

Allows gun dealer or person transferring firearms, firearm accessories, firearm components, ammunition or ammunition components for purchase at gun show, or business engaged in repairing or servicing firearms to establish minimum age of 21 years for such purchases, repairs or services.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon State Police (OSP)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Judiciary to the House Committee on Rules.

The measure allows a gun dealer or person transferring firearms, firearm accessories, firearm components, ammunition or ammunition components for purchase at a gun show, or a business engaged in repairing or servicing firearms, to establish a minimum age of 21 years for such purchases, repairs or services.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on Oregon State Police.
