**Measure Description:**

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to conduct study on effect of prisoner reentry programs on rates of recidivism and present report on findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before September 15, 2020.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Corrections (DOC), Criminal Justice Commission (CJC)

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Judiciary to the House Committee on Rules.

The measure directs the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to conduct a study on the effect of prisoner reentry programs on rates of recidivism and to report their findings to the Legislature on or before September 15, 2020.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Department of Corrections (DOC) and the Criminal Justice Commission (CJC).

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Rules.

Further Analysis Required
