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SUMMARY

Establishes Oregon Human Rights Commission to safeguard dignity and basic human rights of individuals who have intellectual or developmental disabilities.

Requires commission to establish by rule system for statewide regional advisory committees to provide commission with information regarding rights of individuals who have intellectual or developmental disabilities.

Requires commission to receive complaints of violations of rights of individual who has intellectual or developmental disabilities.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure confidential information received by the Oregon Human Rights Commission and materials that relate to the personally identifiable information of an individual alleging a violation or appearing before the commission during an investigation of a potential violation of the rights of a person receiving developmental disability services.

If the public records were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could receive records containing personally identifiable information of individuals alleging a violation of the rights of a person receiving developmental disability services or of a person appearing before the commission during an investigation of a complaint.
