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SUMMARY

Grants to Oregon Health Authority powers to regulate financial condition of coordinated care organizations that align with powers of Department of Consumer and Business Services to regulate domestic insurers.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure a complaint filed with the Oregon Health Authority against a coordinated care organization regarding its financial condition, the record of the complaint and any data collected or reports made by the authority in regulating the financial condition of coordinated care organizations.

If the public records were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could gain additional information regarding complaints received by the Oregon Health Authority related to the financial condition of coordinated care organizations and investigations conducted by the authority in regulating the financial condition of coordinated care organizations, including trade secret information of coordinated care organizations.
