**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Urges Congress to enact Individuals with Disabilities Education Full Funding Act which fully funds the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Needs of students with disabilities

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

**BACKGROUND:**

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) is a law ensuring that students with disabilities are provided with a free appropriate public education by ensuring that education agencies provide special education and related services. IDEA provides guidance and governs how states provide intervention, special education, and related services to eligible children with disabilities. This includes infants, toddlers, children, and youth with disabilities. The Individuals with Disabilities Education Full Funding Act amended IDEA to reauthorize and make appropriations for the grant program to assist states in providing special education to children with disabilities.

HJM 3 A urges Congress to enact the Individuals with Disabilities Education Full Funding Act which fully funds IDEA.
