WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to coordinate with Oregon career and technical student organizations (CTSOs) to: encourage enrollment in CTSO courses; provide financial support; host annual statewide competitive events; provide student recognition and awards; plan and implement participation at Oregon State Fair; and provide general and financial administration of CTSO programs. Appropriates \$1,300,000 from the General Fund for coordination between ODE and CTSOs. Requires ODE to establish and administer grant program for allowing school districts to provide summer CTSO courses. Establishes district qualification requirements. Requires districts to schedule weekly and monthly reports and file annual report with ODE. Requires ODE to collect data from each district to ensure compliance with grant requirements. Appropriates \$900,000 from the General Fund for grant program. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

BACKGROUND:

Career and technical student organizations (CTSOs) provide students with educational and leadership opportunities in various vocational fields. The organizations sponsor competitive events and leadership training to build occupational skills. Some examples of CTSOs include Distributive Education Clubs of America, Future Business Leaders of America, Future Farmers of America, and SkillsUSA.
