Measure Description:

Requires transportation network company that operates in this state to obtain license from Department of Transportation.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS), Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), Cities, Counties

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Revenue to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure requires transportation network companies (TNCs) to be licensed with the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) and outlines registration and operational requirements for TNCs. Further, this measure includes requirements for TNC driver insurance and qualifications. ODOT may charge TNCs an annual fee and conduct inspections of TNC records to ensure compliance with this measure. For every prearranged ride provided by a TNC, ODOT may impose a fee to fund administration of this measure. Certain local governments may also impose a fee.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on ODOT, the Department of Consumer and Business Services, Cities, and Counties.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
