WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Directs Secretary of State to conduct study of special elections held since January 1, 2015. Requires study to include whether elections create barriers to franchise, including financial impact on state and counties and whether elections create disproportionate impact on members of protected class, veterans, persons with a disability, and rural and nonurban voters. Requires report to Legislative Assembly by January 1, 2021. Sunsets on January 2, 2022.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:
