

House Bill 2046

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Governor Kate Brown for Oregon State Police)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of State Police to maintain staffing level of at least 15 patrol troopers per 100,000 residents of this state, beginning January 1, 2030.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to patrol trooper staffing levels for Department of State Police troopers.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of State Police shall maintain a patrol trooper staffing level**
5 **of at least 15 patrol troopers per 100,000 residents of this state, based on population figures**
6 **from the most recent federal decennial census.**

7 **SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2019 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2030.**

8 **(2) The Department of State Police may take any action before the operative date speci-**
9 **fied in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary for the department to exercise, on and**
10 **after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions**
11 **and powers conferred on the department by section 1 of this 2019 Act.**
