House Bill 2057

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Increases maximum fees for commercial weighing or measuring instruments or devices. Limits rate of fee increases during licensing periods beginning before July 1, 2026.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to State Department of Agriculture maximum license fees; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 618.136 and 618.141. 3

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4

SECTION 1. ORS 618.136 is amended to read: $\mathbf{5}$

618.136. (1) The license fee for each type or class of commercial weighing or measuring instru-6 ment or device shall be established by the State Department of Agriculture in an amount not to 7 8 exceed the maximum limits [set forth in] under ORS 618.141. Such fees shall be established in the amounts necessary for the department to carry out and enforce the provisions of ORS 618.010 to 9 618.246 relating to the supervision of commercial weighing and measuring instruments or devices, 10 and to maintain an emergency fund with an unencumbered balance in an amount not to exceed the 11 12 cost of administering ORS 618.010 to 618.246 during a representative four-month period in order to [assure] ensure the orderly supervision of commercial weighing and measuring instruments or de-1314 vices within this state.

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(2) License fees become past due July 1 each year for renewals, and on the date of first com-16 mercial use for original installations.

17(3) Except as provided in this subsection, the department may not establish a license fee under this section that is more than three percent higher than the license fee charged during 18 19 the preceding year for a commercial weighing or measuring instrument or device of the same 20 type and class. Notwithstanding the three percent limit but subject to the maximum limits under ORS 618.141, when establishing a license fee under this section the department may 2122round the fee amount to the next higher whole dollar amount. The department may not 23change the license fee for the same type and class of commercial weighing or measuring in-24 strument or device more than once each year.

25[(3)] (4) All moneys received by the department pursuant to ORS 618.010 to 618.246 shall be paid 26 into the Department of Agriculture Service Fund. Such moneys are continuously appropriated to the department for the purpose of administering those provisions of ORS 618.010 to 618.246 relating to 27 testing, inspection, licensing and regulation of commercial weighing and measuring instruments or 28 devices. 29

Such fees shall be established in the amounts nec-3 essary for the department to carry out and enforce the provisions of ORS 618.010 to 618.246 relating 4 to the supervision of commercial weighing and measuring instruments or devices, and to maintain 5 an emergency fund with an unencumbered balance in an amount not to exceed the cost of adminis-6 tering ORS 618.010 to 618.246 during a representative four-month period in order to ensure the or-7 derly supervision of commercial weighing and measuring instruments or devices within this state.

Such moneys are continuously appropriated to the department for the purpose of administering those provisions of ORS 618.010 to 618.246 relating to testing, inspection, licensing and regulation of commercial weighing and measuring instruments or devices.
