

# House Bill 2138

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Revenue)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Extends sunset for tax credit for provision of volunteer emergency medical services in rural area.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 66, chapter 832, Oregon Laws 2005, as amended by section 26, chapter 913,  
6 Oregon Laws 2009, and section 16, chapter 750, Oregon Laws 2013, is amended to read:

7 **Sec. 66.** ORS 315.622 applies to tax credit certifications issued by the Office of Rural Health  
8 on or after January 1, 2006, and before January 1, [2020] **2026**.
