HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2202

Delete lines 4 through 19 of the printed A-engrossed bill and insert: 1 2 "SECTION 1. (1) The Bureau of Labor and Industries shall develop and administer a 3 program to conduct outreach to veterans to: "(a) Inform them about trade careers; and 4 "(b) Connect them with available apprenticeship opportunities. $\mathbf{5}$ 6 "(2) The bureau may issue grants to trade unions and trade associations to be used to 7 conduct outreach through job fairs or similar recruitment methods. "(3) The bureau may enter into one or more agreements with other state agencies, in-8 9 cluding the Department of Veterans' Affairs, the Employment Department and the Depart-10 ment of Transportation, for the purpose of identifying veterans for outreach purposes. "(4) The bureau shall adopt rules to administer and implement the provisions of this 11 12section. 13 "(5) As used in this section, 'veteran' means a resident of Oregon who: "(a) Is a veteran as defined in ORS 408.225; or 14 "(b) Served in the Oregon National Guard or a reserve component of the Armed Forces 15of the United States. 16 "SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 17 18 \$250,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Veterans' Services Fund es-19 20 tablished under ORS 406.140 to the Bureau of Labor and Industries for the purpose of im-21plementing the provisions of section 1 of this 2019 Act.".

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
