(1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is ap-3 propriated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the biennium beginning 4 $\mathbf{5}$ July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,526,167 for distribution to the Oregon Campus Resilience Consortium for the purpose of implementing emergency response, conti-6 nuity and recovery initiatives at post-secondary educational institutions in this state, which 7 may include: 8 9 "(a) Development of a statewide training program focusing on prevention, preparedness, 10 incident response, continuity of operations and recovery, including the establishment of all-11 hazard incident management teams to serve post-secondary educational institutions in this 12state; 13 "(b) Development of a mutual-aid agreement process for post-secondary educational in-14 stitutions in this state; 15"(c) Development of campus-specific training and outreach materials for preparedness 16 and mitigation to benefit students, faculty and staff of post-secondary educational insti-17 tutions in this state; and 18 "(d) Establishment of an online resource-sharing and collaboration center for higher ed-19 ucation practitioners charged with maintaining campus safety, emergency preparedness and 20 disaster resilience. 21"(2) As used in this section, 'post-secondary educational institution' means: "(a) A public university listed in ORS 352.002; 22"(b) A community college as defined in ORS 341.005; 23 24 "(c) The Oregon Health and Science University; and 25"(d) A nonprofit private school that is authorized to confer academic degrees under ORS 348.594 to 348.615. 2627"SECTION 2. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 28peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect July 1, 2019.". 2930
