House Bill 2230

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Limits amount of overtime nursing staff who work in correctional facility may be required to work.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to mandatory overtime for nursing staff in correctional facilities; amending ORS 653.268.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 653.268 is amended to read:
5	653.268. (1) Labor directly employed by any public employer as defined in ORS 243.650 shall be
6	compensated, if budgeted funds for such purpose are available, for overtime worked in excess of 40
7	hours in any one week, at not less than one and one-half times the regular rate of such employment.
8	If budgeted funds are not available for the payment of overtime, such overtime shall be allowed in
9	compensatory time off at not less than time and a half for employment in excess of 40 hours in any
10	one week.
11	(2) Nothing in this section shall prevent a labor organization under the National Labor Re-
12	lations Act or ORS 243.650 to 243.782 or other employees from negotiating additional overtime pay
13	requirements with a public employer.
14	(3) Regardless of the availability of budgeted funds, if mandatory overtime is assigned,
15	nursing staff directly employed in a correctional facility may not be required to work:
16	(a) Beyond the agreed-upon and prearranged shift, regardless of the length of the shift;
17	(b) More than 48 hours in any workweek;
18	(c) More than 12 hours in a 24-hour period; or
19	(d) During the 10-hour period immediately following the 12th hour worked during a
20	24-hour period.
21	(4) As used in this section:
22	(a) "Correctional facility" means a Department of Corrections institution or jail.
23	(b) "Nursing staff" has the meaning given that term in ORS 441.179.
24
