

House Bill 2376

Sponsored by Representative SMITH DB, Senator HEARD; Representative LEIF (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys to State Parks and Recreation Department for outreach and development of educational signs warning public about natural dangers of ocean beaches.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to ocean beaches; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the State Parks and Recreation Department, for the**
5 **biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____ for outreach**
6 **and development of educational signs that warn the public about the natural dangers of**
7 **ocean beaches, to be posted at key public beach access sites in this state.**

8 **SECTION 2. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
9 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect**
10 **July 1, 2019.**
