

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2449

By COMMITTEE ON VETERANS AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “and 403.240” and insert “, 403.235 and 403.240 and
2 section 4, chapter 5, Oregon Laws 2002 (first special session)”.

3 On page 2, line 13, before “one” insert “one-half of”.

4 In line 18, delete “four” and insert “two”.

5 On page 3, lines 25 through 31, restore the bracketed material and delete the boldfaced material.

6 After line 39, insert:

7 “**SECTION 3.** Section 4, chapter 5, Oregon Laws 2002 (first special session), as amended by
8 section 1, chapter 4, Oregon Laws 2002 (third special session), section 1, chapter 629, Oregon Laws
9 2007, section 1, chapter 749, Oregon Laws 2013, and section 9, chapter 59, Oregon Laws 2014, is
10 amended to read:

11 “**Sec. 4.** Taxes imposed under ORS 403.200 apply to subscriber bills issued on or after January
12 1, 2002, and before January 1, [2022] **2030**, and to retail transactions made on or after October 1,
13 2015, and before January 1, [2022] **2030**.”

14 “**SECTION 4.** ORS 403.235 is amended to read:

15 “403.235. (1) The Emergency Communications Account is established separate and distinct from
16 the General Fund in the State Treasury. All moneys received by the Department of Revenue pursu-
17 ant to ORS 403.200 to 403.230 and interest thereon must be paid to the State Treasurer to be held
18 in a suspense account established under ORS 293.445. After payment of refunds, the balance of the
19 moneys received must be paid into the State Treasury and credited to the Emergency Communi-
20 cations Account. **Interest earned by the account must be credited to the 9-1-1 Subaccount**
21 **established under subsection (2) of this section.** All moneys in the [account] **Emergency Com-**
22 **munications Account** are continuously appropriated to the Office of Emergency Management and
23 must be used for the purposes described in ORS 403.240.

24 “(2) The 9-1-1 Subaccount is established as a subaccount of the Emergency Communications
25 Account. Thirty-five percent of the amount in the Emergency Communications Account on the date
26 of distribution must be credited to the 9-1-1 Subaccount. **Interest earned by the subaccount must**
27 **be credited to the subaccount.** All moneys in the [account] **subaccount** are continuously appro-
28 priated to the Office of Emergency Management and must be used for the purposes described in ORS
29 403.240 (3), (4) and (5).”.
