

House Bill 2473

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Judiciary)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires forensic laboratory to test blood or urine sample within 90 days of receiving sample in prosecution of driving while under influence of intoxicants.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to driving while under the influence of intoxicants.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "forensic laboratory" means a forensic laboratory**
5 **established by the Department of State Police under ORS 181A.150 that is accredited by a**
6 **national forensic accrediting organization.**

7 **(2) Within 90 days of receiving a blood or urine sample in a prosecution of driving while**
8 **under the influence of intoxicants under ORS 813.010, a forensic laboratory shall test a**
9 **person's blood or urine to determine the alcoholic content of the person's blood or urine, or**
10 **both, and for the purpose of determining the presence of cannabis, a controlled substance**
11 **or an inhalant in the person.**
