

House Bill 2523

Sponsored by Representative DOHERTY (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows appointed agent or distillery retail outlet agent for Oregon Liquor Control Commission to deliver distilled liquor to retail purchaser.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1 Relating to distilled liquor delivery.

2 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

3 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 471.**

4 **SECTION 2. (1) An agent appointed by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission under ORS**
5 **471.750, or a distillery retail outlet agent appointed by the commission under ORS 471.230,**
6 **may deliver factory-sealed containers of distilled liquor that are on the list of products ap-**
7 **proved by the commission for retail sale in Oregon. Any deliveries by the agent are subject**
8 **to any rules adopted by the commission relating to deliveries made under this subsection.**
9 **Deliveries under this subsection:**

10 **(a) May be made only to a person who is at least 21 years of age;**

11 **(b) May be made only for personal use and not for the purpose of resale; and**

12 **(c) Must be made in containers that are conspicuously labeled with the words: "CON-**
13 **TAINS ALCOHOL: SIGNATURE OF PERSON AGE 21 YEARS OR OLDER REQUIRED FOR**
14 **DELIVERY."**

15 **(2) The agent that makes deliveries of distilled liquor must take all actions necessary to**
16 **ensure that a carrier used by the agent does not deliver any distilled liquor unless the car-**
17 **rier:**

18 **(a) Obtains the signature of the recipient of the distilled liquor upon delivery;**

19 **(b) Verifies by inspecting government-issued photo identification that the recipient is at**
20 **least 21 years of age; and**

21 **(c) Determines that the recipient is not visibly intoxicated at the time of delivery.**

22 **(3) Any person who knowingly or negligently delivers distilled liquor under the provisions**
23 **of this section to a person under 21 years of age, or who knowingly or negligently delivers**
24 **distilled liquor under the provisions of this section to a visibly intoxicated person, violates**
25 **ORS 471.410.**
