House Bill 2553

Sponsored by Representative EVANS (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires State Fish and Wildlife Commission to adopt certain requirements related to carcasses of returning hatchery fish.

Requires State Department of Fish and Wildlife to conduct analysis of return rates of hatchery fish and report results to Legislative Assembly.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to returning hatchery fish.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of the wildlife laws. 4

 $\mathbf{5}$ SECTION 2. The State Fish and Wildlife Commission shall adopt rules governing the

6 disposition of carcasses of adult hatchery produced fish returning to hatchery facilities that 7 include but are not limited to requirements that:

8 (1) At least 50 percent of the carcasses from all adult hatchery produced fish returning 9 to hatchery facilities must be retained and placed at seasonally appropriate times in natural 10 spawning and rearing areas to enhance nutrient recycling, consistent with pathology con-11 straints; and

12(2) When selling eggs and carcasses from hatchery facilities to provide revenues to support hatchery programs and facilities, the State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall pri-13 14 oritize sales to, in the following order:

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(a) Oregon small businesses in communities with high rates of unemployment; and

16 (b) Oregon small businesses.

17 SECTION 3. (1) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall biennially conduct an 18 analysis of the annual return rates of hatchery produced fish, with particular emphasis on the effect of the return rates on the state's ability to meet its obligations under the Pacific 19 20 Salmon Treaty Act of 1985 (16 U.S.C. 3631 to 3645). The department shall prepare a report 21on the results of the analysis conducted under this section, and may make recommendations for legislation, to the committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the environment and 22 23 natural resources in the manner provided in ORS 192.245 not later than February 1 of each 24 odd-numbered year.

25(2) The department shall post the report prepared pursuant to subsection (1) of this 26 section on the department's website.

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
