

# House Bill 2628

Sponsored by Representative SANCHEZ (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Repeals provisions relating to use of incremental baseball tax revenues to finance major league stadium.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to baseball tax revenues; creating new provisions; and repealing ORS 184.400, 184.402,  
3 184.404, 184.406 and 184.408.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. ORS 184.400, 184.402, 184.404, 184.406 and 184.408 are repealed.**

6 **SECTION 2. Any balance in the Major League Stadium Grant Fund that is unexpended**  
7 **or unobligated on the date of the repeal of ORS 184.408 by section 1 of this 2019 Act, and all**  
8 **moneys that would have been deposited in the Major League Stadium Grant Fund had ORS**  
9 **184.408 stayed in effect, shall be transferred to and deposited in the General Fund to be**  
10 **available for general governmental purposes.**
