## House Bill 2629

Sponsored by Representative SANCHEZ (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Superintendent of Public Instruction to establish parent outreach program at Oregon School for the Deaf.

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the Oregon School for the Deaf; amending ORS 346.020.

## **3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 346.020 is amended to read:

5 346.020. (1) The Superintendent of Public Instruction shall prescribe the course of instruction for 6 students enrolled in the school operated under ORS 346.010. The State Board of Education shall 7 determine the procedures for placement, development of services and operation of the school in 8 conformance with state and federal laws relating to children who are eligible for special education 9 and shall adopt the procedures by rule.

10 (2) The Superintendent of Public Instruction shall select a director for the school. The super-11 intendent may also select teachers and other personnel necessary to manage the school in an ef-12 fective and efficient manner or may delegate the selection of teachers and other personnel to the 13 director of the school.

(3) The Superintendent of Public Instruction shall establish a parent outreach program
at the school. The purpose of the program is to provide parents of enrolled students with
support, mentors and education.

17 [(3)] (4) The Superintendent of Public Instruction shall have control over persons enrolled in the 18 school and shall direct their care and promote their mental, moral and physical welfare.

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
