## House Bill 2715

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires school districts to provide instruction on organ and tissue donation and education. Takes effect July 1, 2020.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to transplant education in public schools.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As an integral part of the health education curriculum for students in

5 the public schools of this state, each school district must provide at least 15 minutes of in-

6 struction per school year on organ and tissue donation and education. The instruction must

7 be designed to develop a knowledge of the lifesaving potential of organ and tissue donations.

8 (2) The Department of Education may provide technical assistance in developing the 9 curriculum required under this section.

10 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act first applies to the 2020-2021 school year.

11 SECTION 3. This 2019 Act takes effect on July 1, 2020.

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
