SUMMARY

Classifies certain persons as resident persons for purpose of purchasing licenses, tags and permits issued by State Fish and Wildlife Commission.

2 Relating to State Fish and Wildlife Commission fees.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The following persons are resident persons for purposes of purchasing li-5 censes, tags and permits issued by the State Fish and Wildlife Commission:

6 (1) A person who pays out-of-state tuition at an Oregon institution of higher education 7 within 12 months prior to purchasing the license, tag or permit; or

8 (2) A person who presents an Oregon tax return establishing that the person satisfied a

9 state income tax liability within 12 months prior to purchasing the license, tag or permit.
