SUMMARY

[Directs Department of Education to conduct study to determine adequacy of public education in state.]

[Directs department to submit report to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to education no later than September 15, 2020.]

[Sunsets December 31, 2020.]

[Declares emergency, effective on passage.]

Directs Department of Education to create Oregon Education Support Professional of the Year Program.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to education.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Department of Education shall create an Oregon Education Support 5 Professional of the Year Program.

6 (2) Each year, in collaboration with the Oregon State Lottery Commission, the Depart-7 ment of Education shall honor and recognize at least one outstanding education support

8 professional that serves students in any grade from prekindergarten through grade 12.

9 (3) To qualify for an award, a candidate or another person on behalf of a candidate shall
10 demonstrate that the candidate:

(a) Excels in the candidate's field and guides students of all backgrounds and abilities to
achieve excellence.

13 (b) Collaborates with colleagues, students and families to create a school culture of re-

14 spect and success.

15 (c) Demonstrates leadership and innovation.

16 (d) Communicates in an engaging and articulate way.

17 (4) The State Board of Education may adopt rules specifying:

18 (a) The application process;

19 (b) The selection criteria that will be used in awarding the Oregon Education Support

20 **Professional of the Year award; and**

21 (c) Any duties of the recipient after receiving the award.
