

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2969

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 30.

2 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 13 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) For the purpose of assisting public bodies and private entities that serve**
4 **children, adolescents and families in providing trauma-informed services, the Oregon De-**
5 **partment of Administrative Services shall enter into a contract with a nonprofit organization**
6 **that:**

7 **“(a) Has expertise in developing and providing trauma-informed practices and policies;**

8 **“(b) Demonstrates the ability to perform statewide outreach;**

9 **“(c) Has a record of working with state agencies; and**

10 **“(d) Is part of an academic research-based institution.**

11 **“(2) The contract shall provide that the nonprofit organization shall create a trauma-**
12 **informed practice integration program in coordination and collaboration with public bodies**
13 **and private entities that serve children, adolescents and families, including but not limited**
14 **to persons who represent:**

15 **“(a) The Department of Human Services.**

16 **“(b) The Oregon Youth Authority.**

17 **“(c) The Department of Education.**

18 **“(d) The Oregon Health Authority.**

19 **“(e) The Youth Development Council.**

20 **“(f) School districts.**

21 **“(g) Nonprofit organizations.**

22 **“(h) County public health programs.**

23 **“(i) Juvenile crime prevention programs.**

24 **“(j) Early Learning Hubs.**

25 **“(k) School health providers.**

26 **“(L) State and local law enforcement agencies.**

27 **“(m) The Department of Corrections.**

28 **“(n) The Department of Justice.**

29 **“(o) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission.**

30 **“(p) District attorneys.**

31 **“(q) The Judicial Department.**

32 **“(3) The trauma-informed practice integration program shall:**

33 **“(a) Clearly define the characteristics of the target population of children, adolescents**
34 **and families to be served by the program.**

35 **“(b) Review trauma-informed practice integration programs in other states.**

- 1 “(c) Define what it means to provide trauma-informed services.
- 2 “(d) Develop a list of performance measures that measure the success of public bodies
- 3 and private entities in providing trauma-informed services to the target population.
- 4 “(e) Identify trauma-informed policies and services underway across this state.
- 5 “(f) Coordinate trauma-informed initiatives across state agencies.
- 6 “(g) Identify systemic barriers to and gaps in services.
- 7 “(h) Leverage existing trauma-informed resources and initiatives to encourage consist-
- 8 ency and eliminate duplication of resources.
- 9 “(i) Recommend changes to existing trauma-informed practices and policies.
- 10 “(4) The contract entered into under this section shall provide that the nonprofit organ-
- 11 ization shall submit an annual report to the Legislative Assembly and the Governor:
- 12 “(a) Detailing the progress made in carrying out the provisions of this section; and
- 13 “(b) Containing specific recommendations for any additional legislation the organization
- 14 deems necessary to carry out the purposes of the trauma-informed practice integration
- 15 program.
- 16 “(5) As used in this section, ‘public body’ has the meaning given that term in ORS
- 17 174.109.”.

18 In line 15, delete “office of the Governor” and insert “Oregon Department of Administrative

19 Services”.

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
