House Bill 3040

Sponsored by Representative HELM

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows outdoor production of homegrown marijuana for recreational use. Authorizes Oregon Liquor Control Commission to adopt rules.

Allows outdoor production of medical marijuana by specified registry identification cardholder. Authorizes Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

2	Relating to marijuana production; and prescribing an effective date.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 475B.010 to
5	475B.545.
6	SECTION 2. (1) Homegrown marijuana produced as provided by ORS 475B.301 may be
7	produced outdoors if the production is not in violation of ORS 475B.306.
8	(2) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission may adopt rules to carry out this section.
9	SECTION 3. Section 4 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 475B.785 to
10	475B.949.
11	SECTION 4. (1) A registry identification cardholder that produces marijuana for use by
12	the registry identification cardholder may produce the marijuana at an outdoor marijuana
13	grow site.
14	(2) The Oregon Health Authority may adopt rules to carry out this section.
15	SECTION 5. (1) Sections 2 and 4 of this 2019 Act become operative on January 1, 2020.
16	(2) The Oregon Health Authority and the Oregon Liquor Control Commission may take
17	any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is neces-
18	sary to enable the authority and the commission to exercise, on and after the operative date
19	specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions and powers conferred
20	on the authority and the commission by sections 2 and 4 of this 2019 Act.
21	SECTION 6. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2019
22	regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
