

House Bill 3059

Sponsored by Representatives RESCHKE, NEARMAN

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires ultrasound at least 72 hours before abortion. Imposes civil penalties.
Becomes operative January 1, 2020.
Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to abortion; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) Except in the case of a medical emergency, an ultrasound with standard**
5 **assessment of fetus' developmental status must be performed on an individual who under-**
6 **goes an abortion at least 72 hours before the abortion is performed.**

7 **(2) The Oregon Health Authority shall impose a civil penalty of \$2,000 on a health care**
8 **facility, as defined in ORS 442.015, where an abortion is performed in violation of subsection**
9 **(1) of this section. Civil penalties under this subsection shall be imposed in the manner pro-**
10 **vided in ORS 183.745. Civil penalties recovered under this subsection shall be paid into the**
11 **State Treasury and credited to the Oregon Health Authority Fund.**

12 **(3) The authority may adopt rules necessary to administer this section.**

13 **(4) Compliance with or the administration of this section is not a violation of ORS 659.880.**

14 **SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2019 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2020.**

15 **(2) The Oregon Health Authority may take any action before the operative date specified**
16 **in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the authority to exercise, on and**
17 **after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions**
18 **and powers conferred on the authority by section 1 of this 2019 Act.**

19 **SECTION 3. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2019**
20 **regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
