## House Bill 3142

Sponsored by Representative DOHERTY

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires each post-secondary institution of education that operates in Oregon and enrolls students who receive federal financial aid or state financial aid to provide specified data on current and former students to Higher Education Coordinating Commission. Requires commission to make data publicly accessible in easy to understand format.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to disclosure of information by post-secondary institutions of education.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 348.

5 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) Each post-secondary institution of education that operates in this state

6 and that enrolls students who receive federal financial aid or state financial aid shall provide

7 on an annual basis to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission:

- 8 (a) The percentage of students enrolled at the institution who receive:
- 9 (A) Federal grants or scholarships;
- 10 (B) Federal student loans;
- 11 (C) State grants or scholarships;
- 12 (D) State student loans;
- 13 (E) Private student loans;
- 14 (F) Private scholarships;
- 15 (G) Institution-based grants or scholarships; and
- 16 (H) Institution-based student loans.
- 17 (b) The rate at which students enrolled at the institution complete the program in which
- 18 they are enrolled.

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(c) The mean and median amount of federal student loan debt owed by students who were
formerly enrolled at the institution and who completed the program in which they were en rolled.

(d) The mean and median amount of federal student loan debt owed by students who were
formerly enrolled at the institution and did not complete the program in which they were
enrolled.

(e) The rate at which students who were previously enrolled at the institution are in
default on their student loan debts.

(f) The rate at which students enrolled at the institution transfer to other post-secondary
institutions of education.

(g) The rate at which students who graduate from the institution continue to subsequent
levels of education.

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1	(h) The percentage of students who were previously enrolled at the institution who re-
<b>2</b>	ceived a degree or certificate in the program in which the student was initially enrolled.
3	(i) The percentage of students who were previously enrolled at the institution who left
4	the institution without receiving the certificate or degree offered in the program in which
5	the student was enrolled.
6	(2) The information described in subsection (1) of this section shall be provided to the
7	commission disaggregated on the basis of the following:
8	(a) Federal Pell Grant recipients;
9	(b) Federal student loan recipients;
10	(c) Students who did not receive a Federal Pell Grant or other federal student loan;
11	(d) Recipients of Veterans' benefits or Survivors' and Dependents' Educational Assist-
12	ance under 38 U.S.C. chapter 35;
13	(e) Students who are veterans or who are in the Armed Forces of the United States, as
14	defined in ORS 348.282;
15	(f) Students who are enrolled on a full-time basis;
16	(g) Students who are enrolled on a part-time basis;
17	(h) The race or ethnicity of the students, if identified;
18	(i) The age or age intervals of the students;
19	(j) The gender of the students;
20	(k) Whether a student is a first-generation student;
21	(L) The type of credential sought by the student; and
22	(m) The preparedness for post-secondary education of the student.
23	(3)(a) In addition to the information detailed in subsections (1) and (2) of this section,
24	each post-secondary institution of education described in subsection (1) of this section shall
25	provide on an annual basis to the commission:
26	(A) The mean and median debt-to-earnings ratio for students who were formerly enrolled
27	at the institution; and
28	(B) The mean and median annual salary earned by students who were formerly enrolled
29	at the institution.
30	(b) The information described in paragraph (a) of this subsection shall be provided to the
31	commission disaggregated on the basis of the following:
32	(A) Program of study of the formerly enrolled student;
33	(B) Academic credential received by the formerly enrolled student;
34	(C) Employment status of the formerly enrolled student; and
35	(D) Whether the formerly enrolled student completed the program in which the student
36	was enrolled.
37	(4) The commission shall make the materials provided to the commission under this
38	section publicly accessible in an easy to understand format.
39	(5) The commission may adopt rules necessary to implement this section.
40	SECTION 3. Post-secondary institutions of education are first required to provide the
41	information detailed in section 2 of this 2019 Act to the Higher Education Coordinating
42	Commission no later than September 1, 2024.
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
