

House Bill 3170

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for Senior Farm Direct Nutrition Program and Women, Infants and Children Farm Direct Nutrition Program. Directs Oregon Health Authority to include appropriations for programs in biennial agency request budgets. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium be-**
5 **ginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$286,888 for the Senior Farm**
6 **Direct Nutrition Program.**

7 **SECTION 2. There is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium be-**
8 **ginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,227,421 for the Women, In-**
9 **fant and Children Farm Direct Nutrition Program.**

10 **SECTION 3. In each biennium, the Oregon Health Authority shall, in its agency request**
11 **budget filed under ORS 291.208, request appropriations to fund the Senior Farm Direct Nu-**
12 **trition Program and the Women, Infants and Children Farm Direct Nutrition Program in at**
13 **least the amounts of the appropriations made by sections 1 and 2 of this 2019 Act.**

14 **SECTION 4. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect**
16 **on July 1, 2019.**
