House Bill 3323

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to service animals.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The Department of Education shall conduct a study that examines the current level of use of service animals among students with disabilities and the need for more facilities and provisions to accommodate student use of service animals. The department shall report the results of the study to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to education, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, not later than September 15,
