SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires [certain medical and residential facilities] hospitals and long term care facilities to make available to patients and residents plant-based meals when necessary to accommodate medical, religious, cultural or ethnic needs, preferences or requests.

Requires Department of Corrections to make available to inmates plant-based meals any time meal is served.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to plant-based meals.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 SECTION 1. (1) A hospital or long term care facility shall make available to patients and

5 residents wholesome, plant-based meals when such a meal is necessary to accommodate:

6 (a) The allergies, intolerances or preferences of patients or residents;

7 (b) The religious, cultural or ethnic needs of patients or residents; or

8 (c) Requests from patients or residents for plant-based meals.

9 (2) As used in this section:

(a) "Hospital" and "long term care facility" have the meanings given those terms in ORS
442.015.

(b) "Plant-based meal," also known as a vegan meal, means an entire meal that contains
 no animal products or byproducts including meat, poultry, fish, dairy or eggs.

14 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The Department of Corrections shall make available to all inmates 15 incarcerated in department facilities plant-based meals as an option any time a meal is 16 served.

(2) As used in this section, "plant-based meal," also known as a vegan meal, means an
entire meal that contains no animal products or byproducts including meat, poultry, fish,
dairy or eggs.
