## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3413

1	On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the rest of the line and
2	delete lines 3 through 6 and insert "amending ORS 441.403; and declaring an emergency.".
3	Delete lines 8 through 30 and delete pages 2 through 25 and insert:
4	"SECTION 1. ORS 441.403 is amended to read:
5	"441.403. (1) The office of the Long Term Care Ombudsman is established. The Long Term Care
6	Ombudsman shall function separately and independently from any other state agency. The Governor
7	shall appoint the Long Term Care Ombudsman for a four-year term from a list of three nominees
8	nominated by the Residential Ombudsman and Public Guardianship Advisory Board established un-
9	der ORS 441.416. The appointment of the Long Term Care Ombudsman is subject to Senate confir-
10	mation under ORS 171.562 and 171.565. A vacancy shall be filled within 60 days in the same manner
11	as an appointment is made.
12	"(2) The Long Term Care Ombudsman may be removed for just cause, upon recommendation to
13	the Governor by the Residential Ombudsman and Public Guardianship Advisory Board.
14	"(3) The Long Term Care Ombudsman shall have background and experience in the following
15	areas:
16	"(a) The fields of aging, mental health or developmental disabilities;
17	"(b) Physical or behavioral health care;
18	"(c) Working with community programs;
19	"(d) Strong understanding of long term care issues, both regulatory and policy;
20	"(e) Working with health care providers;
21	"(f) Working with and involvement in volunteer programs; and
22	"(g) Administrative and managerial experience.
23	"(4) The Long Term Care Ombudsman may hire up to 10 deputy ombudsmen as necessary
24	to perform the duties of the ombudsman.
25	"SECTION 2. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
26	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect
27	on its passage.".
