SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Forestry Department for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and certain federal funds, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from certain lottery moneys.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from certain federal funds. Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Emergency Board for allocation to department for [fire protection] certain expenses.

Modifies certain limitations on expenditures by department for biennium ending June 30, 2019.

Declares emergency, effective [July 1, 2019] on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the State Forestry Department; and declaring an emer-3 gency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4

SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the State Forestry Department, for the biennium 5

beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following 6 purposes: 7

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on 35expenditures established by section 2 (2), chapter 592, Oregon Laws 2017, for the biennium 36 ending June 30, 2019, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or 37 38 other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and including federal funds from the United States Forest Service for fire protection and for research projects, but excluding lottery 39 funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter 592, Oregon Laws 2017, collected 40 or received by the State Forestry Department, for fire protection, is increased by \$532,747 41 42 for catastrophic wildfire insurance premium costs for the 2019 fire season. SECTION 8. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 43
