

House Bill 5044

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

- Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Climate Authority for biennial expenses.
- Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by authority.
- Limits biennial expenditures by authority from certain lottery moneys.
- Limits biennial expenditures by authority from federal funds.
- Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.
- Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Oregon Climate Authority; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Oregon Climate Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following purposes:

- (1) Carbon Markets and Policy..... \$ 9,128,620**
- (2) Climate and Energy Policy
and Programs..... \$ 308,214**
- (3) Debt Service..... \$ 4,334,048**
- (4) Administrative Services..... \$ 3,931,301**

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$31,898,669 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Climate Authority.

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$3,023,370 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Oregon Climate Authority for debt service for the energy efficiency and sustainable technology loan program, and for the Public Schools Grant Program.

SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$2,435,545 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Climate Authority.

SECTION 5. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, expenditures by the State Oregon

3 **SECTION 6.** This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
4 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect
5 July 1, 2019.
