

# HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5047

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 Delete lines 4 through 15 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**  
3 **propriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the**  
4 **General Fund, the amount of \$5,504,403 for developing and implementing programs created**  
5 **under chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3427).**

6 **“SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**  
7 **propriated to the Department of Revenue, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the**  
8 **General Fund, the amount of \$2,789,361, for the Corporate Division, for the implementation**  
9 **of the corporate activity tax established under chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled**  
10 **House Bill 3427).**

11 **“SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**  
12 **propriated to the Department of Revenue, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the**  
13 **General Fund, the amount of \$1,165,000 for the core systems replacement program and the**  
14 **implementation of the corporate activity tax established under chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws**  
15 **2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3427).**

16 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
17 **\$472,740,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for**  
18 **payments of grant-in-aid, program costs and purchased services by the Department of Edu-**  
19 **cation from the Student Investment Account established by section 8, chapter \_\_\_, Oregon**  
20 **Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3427).**

21 **“SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**  
22 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limits for payments**  
23 **of grant-in-aid, program costs and purchased services by the Department of Education from**  
24 **the Early Learning Account established by section 51, chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2019 (En-**  
25 **rolled House Bill 3427), for the following purposes:**

- 26 (1) **Early Intervention Services**
- 27 **and Early Childhood Special**
- 28 **Education programs as**
- 29 **defined in ORS 343.035 ..... \$ 37,500,000**
- 30 (2) **Relief Nurseries ..... \$ 2,800,000**

- 32 (4) **Oregon Prekindergarten**
- 33 **program ..... \$ 44,399,232**
- 34 (5) **Early Head Start program..... \$ 22,343,688**

3 “SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
4 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limits for payment  
5 of expenses by the Department of Education from the Early Learning Account established  
6 by section 51, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3427), for the following  
7 programs:

- 8 (1) Professional development for  
9 early learning professionals..... \$ 12,500,000
- 10 (2) Operations..... \$ 2,033,387

11 “SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
12 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limits for payments  
13 of grant-in-aid, program costs and purchased services by the Department of Education from  
14 the Statewide Education Initiatives Account established by section 24, chapter \_\_, Oregon  
15 Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3427), for the following purposes:

- 16 (1) High School Graduation and  
17 College and Career  
18 Readiness Fund..... \$133,200,000
- 19 (2) Nutritional assistance  
20 programs..... \$ 41,607,714
- 21 (3) Reengagement program..... \$ 4,000,000
- 22 (4) Statewide equity initiatives..... \$ 8,000,000
- 23 (5) School safety initiatives..... \$ 1,725,119
- 24 (6) Summer early learning grants.. \$ 3,000,000
- 25 (7) Grants to education service  
26 districts for technical  
27 assistance..... \$ 24,000,000
- 28 (8) Early warning system grants ... \$ 2,750,000
- 29 (9) Student success grants..... \$ 12,000,000

30 “SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
31 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limits for payment  
32 of expenses by the Department of Education from the Statewide Education Initiatives Ac-  
33 count established by section 24, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3427), for  
34 the following purposes:

- 35 (1) Professional development and  
36 training for educators..... \$ 15,000,000
- 37 (2) Operations..... \$ 19,839,266

38 “SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
39 expenditures established by section 2 (6), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled Senate  
40 Bill 5515), as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys, or other re-  
41 venues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, col-  
42 lected or received by the Department of Justice, for the General Counsel Division, is  
43 increased by \$464,086 for the purposes of implementing the provisions of chapter \_\_, Oregon  
44 Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3427).

45 “SECTION 10. Sections 4 to 8 of this 2019 Act become operative on the date that chapter

1 \_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3427), becomes law.

2 “SECTION 11. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
3 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect  
4 July 1, 2019.”

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
